## CHARLOTTESVILLE SYMPHONY CONCERTO COMPETITION

Why: To highlight and celebrate the wide range of student talent in the UVA Music Dept.

Who is eligible: Current UVA students who are taking for-credit private lessons with an instructor in the UVA Music Department *and* are participating in the symphony. Pianists, non-orchestral instruments, and vocalists are exempt from the latter. Past winners are not eligible.

When: Applications are due no later than Friday, October 24, 2025. Late applications will not be accepted. Auditions will take place on Sunday, November 9 between 6-10 pm (individual times will be announced in early November), with a performance on the February 14-15, 2026 concerts.

Where: Auditions will be held in Old Cabell Auditorium.

## Requirements:

- 1. Complete the application form with all required information and faculty signatures (digital or written) and submit via email to the Director of Performance Kelly Sulick: musicdop@virginia.edu
- 2. Complete concerti/concert works *or* selected movements are acceptable. Repertoire must be approved by Charlottesville Symphony Music Director Benjamin Rous and the applicant's applied instructor prior to application.
- 3. Auditions must be performed in-person with live piano accompaniment.
- 4. By entering, applicants confirm their availability for the concert dates and for full orchestra rehearsals on Thursday, February 12, and Friday, February 13, both at 7:30pm in the Old Cabell Hall auditorium. Additionally, a private work session with Professor Rous may be scheduled prior to the first rehearsal at a mutually convenient time.

## Other important information:

- After the application deadline, the student and instructor will be notified of the audition time.
- Performers must bring three copies of the score for the judges.
- Auditions will not be blind.
- Memorization is not required.
- Video entries will not be accepted.
- Piano accompaniment must be arranged by the performer at their own expense.
- The winner will receive four complimentary tickets to each performance.

Who will be judging: Charlottesville Symphony Music Director Benjamin Rous and two faculty CS Principals. The judges may decline to choose a winner.
